Stay safe on the go: Mobile Security Tips

Your phone holds a lot of personal information - keep it secure with these simple mobile safety tips!



Lock your phone – Personal information stored in your phone is more secure when you use a password, passcode, Face ID or fingerprints to unlock it!



Avoid unsecured Wi-Fi – Instead of using public wi-fi when accessing your account, log in via password protected wi-fi or use cellular data to connect.



Beware of links sent via text – Never click on unexpected links via text, especially if the message requests you to log in to your accounts.
